SHORT RANGE CERTIFICATE (VHF DSC)

One-day Classroom Based Course & Exam

Do you have a VHF Radio on your boat, and if so, do you have the necessary licences to use it? Are you aware that if you use your VHF for any purpose other than an emergency call, and there is not at least one qualified person on board your vessel, then you are breaking the law? Most fixed marine VHF radios now have Digital Selective Calling (DSC). Do you know how to use it? Do you know when and how to make a Mayday or Pan Pan call?

Get yourself both competent and legal by attending our one-day course, to be held on **Friday 30th August** and then take the exam straight afterwards. An additional payment of £70 (payable to the RYA) will be required prior to the course for the issue of VHF Licence Application.

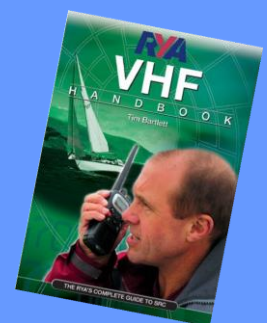
