LEVEL 2 POWERBOAT HANDLING

Aim:

To teach boat handling and seamanship in powerboats. This course may be conducted in a variety of boat types, both planing and displacement, and the certificate issued will be endorsed to show the type of boat in which the training took place.

Duration: Two day

Minimum age: Twelve years old

Course Materials: RYA Powerboat Scheme – Syllabus & logbook (G20) and 'Start powerboating' Course handbook
